

Winter Games Polish Horseshoe Tournament

Location – At the entrance to Emerald Meadows, just west of Oak Hill Marina

Parking across the street at the Amusement Park parking lot or on Emerald Meadows Drive.

Date – Saturday, January 28th

Time – Between 11:00 and 2:00, Finals 2:15 – 3:00

Two-Person Team Event (Must be 21 or older)

Guy's Division, Gals Division, and Mixed Division

Cost - \$20 per 2 person team (includes 1 beer per person, donation to Winter Games and 1 local Charity, and prize money paid in Okoboji Chamber Bucks)

Everyone guaranteed a minimum of 2 games and, depending on sign up, will be double elimination or bracketed match play elimination.

May sign up in advance at Winter Game Headquarters or at tent the day of.

Game Description: The game is a college tailgate or backyard type game played with a Frisbee, one two-person team pitted against another two-person team. The game set-up is much like a backyard horseshoe court or bean bag game toss court, except teammates play from the same end. The object is to knock a bottle off the opposing teams pedestal with a Frisbee toss, scoring points only if the opponents do NOT catch the Frisbee and/or the bottle from the pedestal. Games to 21 points.
